Dr. Mimi is a nationally recognized psychologist, author, and advocate on diversity issues, specifically the LGBT and the Asian Pacific Islander (API) communities. Her tireless LGBT leadership spans almost 20 years, including co-founding 3 bi+ organization in Los Angeles, multiple publications, two invitations to the White House, and being named "One of the Most Significant Women in the Bisexual Movement." Currently Dr. Mimi works as a Staff Psychologist at Loyola Marymount University and as a Professor of Clinical Psychology at Antioch University LA.

Abstract: "Did you know that bisexual, pansexual, and sexually fluid people make up the largest subgroup of the LGB population, yet are the least likely to be out to people close to them? This presents a very important quandary for health and mental health care providers and sets an even greater impetus for us to gain knowledge about bi+ identity, attractions, and behaviors, to improve awareness of incidents of biphobia and bi erasure, and to learn what it takes to truly be a bi-affirmative clinician."
