**About the Presenter:**

Dr. Mimi Hoang is a nationally recognized psychologist, author, and advocate. Her passion to serve the underserved is reflected in her extensive clinical and community work with multicultural groups, especially the lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) and Asian Pacific Islander (API) populations, which has earned her 2 invitations to the White House and mentions in *Cosmopolitan* and *Huff Post*, among other accolades.

Did you know that bisexual, pansexual, and sexually fluid people (AKA "bi+") make up the largest subgroup of the LGB population, yet are the least likely to be out to people close to them? This presents a very important quandary for health and mental health care providers and sets an even greater impetus for us to gain knowledge about bi+ identity, attractions, and behaviors, to improve awareness of incidents of bi-phobia and bi erasure, and to learn what it takes to truly be a bi-affirmative clinician.

- To increase awareness of mental health concerns specific to bi+ individuals
- To learn about bi-affirmative practices in a clinical setting
